Arkansas currently has 17 NAWCA projects either completed or underway. These projects have conserved a total of 77,089 acres of wildlife habitat. NAWCA funding of over \$11.7 million stimulated partner contributions of more than \$41.7 million. These figures do not include multi-state projects.

## WHITE & CACHE RIVERS WETLANDS II

The primary objectives of this project are to acquire, protect, enhance, restore, and to actively manage 2,177 acres of wetlands/floodplain habitats critical and unique to waterfowl, shorebirds, marsh birds, wading birds, forest birds, endangered species, and other wetland dependent wildlife in the Lower White and Cache Rivers Basin (LWCRB) of the Lower Mississippi Valley (LMV).

This diverse tract of land consists of mature bottomland hardwood trees, moist-soil wetlands, an oxbow lake, and a field that will be reforested by the grantee. Additionally, within the area a perpetual conservation-easement will be donated to the NWR. Habitat acquired, protected, restored, or enhanced thorough this project will benefit five high priority waterfowl species (mallards, northern pintails, lesser and greater scaup, American black duck), five other priority waterfowl species (wood duck, ring-necked duck, American widgeon, redhead, and canvasback), and over 21 different waterfowl species in total.
