*Delaware currently has 10 NAWCA projects either completed or underway. These projects have conserved a total of 10,803 acres of wildlife habitat. NAWCA funding of more than \$6 million stimulated partner contributions of over \$12.6 million. These figures do not include multi-state projects.*

## DELAWARE'S DECLINING WETLAND HABITATS

Project partners will protect, restore and enhance 2,067 acres of wetlands and associated uplands throughout Delaware, on private lands and public access areas. Project activities will reduce the rate of wetland loss and conversion seen in recent years and address habitat protection, restoration and enhancement goals of several national and international bird management plans.

The project area is an important part of a major migration corridor for waterfowl and other wetland-associated migratory birds in the Atlantic Flyway. Restoration and protection of these habitats will provide migratory stopover and wintering habitat, and breeding and foraging habitat for waterfowl, passerines, shorebirds and other waterbirds.
