New Jersey currently has 19 NAWCA projects either completed or underway. These projects have conserved a total of 54,993 acres of wildlife habitat. NAWCA funding of more than \$11.6 million stimulated partner contributions of over \$61.8 million. These figures do not include multi-state projects.

SOUTHEAST NEW JERSEY COASTAL INITIATIVE

This project is the start of a multi-phase effort to protect, restore, and enhance native wetland communities under threat from invasive species. In addition, severe damage to coastal habitats from natural disasters continues to affect the area's natural resources and its critical habitats for migratory birds.

This project will protect and enhance nearly 6,000 acres of wetlands surrounding the Tuckahoe Wildlife Management Area, linking together more than 56,000 acres of state and county lands. This area hosts one of the only remaining wetlands still dominated by native vegetation and an important transition zone between forest and wetlands. The project will adjust water flows to increase foraging and nesting habitat, benefiting American black duck, northern pintail, forester's tern, gull-billed tern, American woodcock, black rail, saltmarsh sparrow, eastern kingbird, and other migratory waterfowl, waterbirds, shorebirds, and songbirds.
