New York currently has 36 NAWCA projects either completed or underway. These projects have conserved a total of 90,183 acres of wildlife habitat. NAWCA funding of more than \$10.8 million stimulated partner contributions of over \$50.4 million. These figures do not include multi-state projects.

LAKE ONTARIO WATERSHED II

This project is the second of a planned three-phase effort to protect and restore wetlands and migratory bird habitats on southern and eastern Lake Ontario. The current phase includes protecting 691 acres of wetland and 1,265 acres of adjacent buffering uplands, restoring and enhancing 141 acres of managed land located in the three most productive waterfowl areas in the Lake Ontario Plain and contributing 3,387 acres in and around the largest privately-owned conservation area in the state.

This mosaic of wetland and buffering uplands are mostly on large, road-less tracts provide very high quality breeding and stopover habitat which supports high populations of waterfowl and migratory birds, with multiple areas designated as Important Bird Areas. Many of the Highest Priority species of BCR 14 and those species of Greatest Conservation Need in New York were recorded in or near the tracts identified for protection.
