Washington currently has 62 NAWCA projects either completed or underway. These projects have conserved a total of 120,133 acres of wildlife habitat. NAWCA funding of more than \$28 million stimulated partner contributions of over \$111.6 million. These figures do not include multi-state projects.

CENTRAL PUGET LOWLANDS PROJECT

The Central Puget Lowlands Project is an ongoing collaboration to conserve wetland habitats in the Puget Sound region, with an emphasis on protecting and restoring floodplain wetlands. The region contains some of the most diverse and biologically significant wetland complexes in the United States.

Project partners will acquire an estimated 166 acres of wetlands and associated uplands in fee title and conservation easement, restore an estimated 339 acres of wetlands and associated uplands, and enhance an estimated 12 acres of wetlands in the Puget Sound region. Restoration activities will result in self-sustaining, resilient habitats that will provide long term benefits to over 150 bird species, other wildlife and fish. Public access on some project tracts will allow environmental education and research, hiking, bird watching, wildlife photography, hunting, and other recreation.
